Cartridges used for input and output cannot contain XD*ed sectors. If an error condition is detected while attempting to read or write, appropriate retries are made. If the retry cannot be made successfully, then the copy between the two drives will not be allowed. The cartridge label is checked for validity, but is not copied.
