I. The arqument is considered to have a sign and three binary integer positions, whereas the result is considered to have the binary point immediately to the right of the sign. The argument may vary from \$\frac{2}{2}\$ pi radians to \$-2\$ pi radians, whereas the result varies from \$-.377777\$ (almost \$\frac{1}{2}.0). These subroutines use the "modified multiply" subroutine.
