Fast information entry

Up-to-date files and timely reports greatly assist the decision-making process. To help you achieve this information control, we designed the HP 250 for fast, easy and accurate entry of information.

Just type in your data on the typewriter-like keyboard. It's arranged like most electric office typewriters, with a few additional keys for special procedures. And there's a familiar, ten-key numeric pad to speed numeric data entry.

Besides its familiar design, the keyboard's sculpted keycaps and

precision key mechanism encourage the speed of touch-typing. And because the keyboard is detached, it can be placed to suit the comfort of each individual user.

Simplified system use

The HP 250 was designed to be used with very little computer knowledge or training so your employees can quickly become more productive. And you won't need to hire a full-time operator —with just a little practice, your existing employees can operate the system.

On HP 250 Models 30 and above, an integral high-speed tape cartridge illustrates one of the HP 250's innovations in operator convenience. A single cartridge stores the equivalent of several flexible discs, freeing operator time spent in exchanging diskettes, as well as reducing consumables costs and storage space. Plus, it records data much faster than storage devices typically associated with small business systems.

As another example of operator convenience, the keyboard features a special set of eight innovative soft keys. These keys are programmable and can be dynamically relabeled to facilitate faster, more accurate user input. Forms can also be displayed at the workstations with underlining, inverse video, and boxes to highlight prompting messages, input fields, and important status information.

prising that the HP 250 is being used in more and more applications every day.


Plenty of room for growth

Data Base Management

IMAGE/250 is a comprehensive subset of the award-winning HP 3000 data base management package. A collection of programs and easy-to-use commands, it has the power to create, control and maintain a complex information management system, making tailoring a solution to your problems easier, and less expensive. Data security is assured by password-protected access to your data files.

Among the several unique features offered by IMAGE/250 is the ability to perform FIND and SORT operations across data sets with logical "threading." Sort operations can be alphanumeric or numeric; sort fields in either ascending or descending order, from different data sets, can be selected.

QUERY/250

QUERY/250, a companion to IMAGE/250, serves as a convenient and speedy way to retrieve, update or modify data—without actually having to write

any programs.

QUERY/250 interacts with the data base management system simplifying unprogrammed access to your stored information. QUERY/250 prompts appearing on the display help the user gather facts needed on a one-time basis (for example, listing customers who made a purchase over \$100 in the past month, or checking available stock on a specific item).

FORMS/250

The unique FORMS/250 software benefits both the programmer and you. With it, the programmer can easily simulate most of your existing forms on the screen—so the system adapts to your way of doing things. It takes less time to personalize forms on the HP 250 than it does on most other systems.

The ability to display forms on the screen facilitates information entry. Once the blanks are filled on the form, as when processing an order, pressing a button logs the entire transaction. This technique reduces errors, speeds data entry and requires little operator training.

REPORT WRITER/250

The reports generated by the computer are for your use, so it makes sense that they be tailored to your needs. REPORT WRITER/ 250 gives the programmer a versatile set of commands with which to format final, professional looking reports that can include totals, averages, and summaries—all without writing complicated programs.
