



# HEWLETT-PACKARD SALES INFORMATION

Sales — Sales for fiscal year 1981 were \$3.6 billion. Net earnings were \$312 million. For the first half of fiscal year 1982, sales totaled \$2.01 billion, a 22% increase over the corresponding period of 1981. Net earnings were \$167 million. Electronic data products accounted for 50% of total sales.

Hewlett-Packard is a major designer and manufacturer of precision electronics equipment for measurement, analysis and computation. The company employs more than 64,500 people and operates approximately 50 manufacturing facilities worldwide.

- Domestic Operations include manufacturing facilities in Cupertino, Mountain View, Palo Alto, Roseville, San Diego, San Jose, Santa Clara, Santa Rosa, and Sunnyvale in California; Colorado Springs, Fort Collins and Loveland in Colorado; Boise, Idaho; Andover and Waltham in Massachusetts; Rockaway, New Jersey; Corvallis and McMinnville in Oregon; Avondale, Pennsylvania; Spokane, Vancouver and Lake Stevens in Washington.
- International Operations include manufacturing facilities in Campinas, Brazil; Grenoble, France; Boeblingen and Waldbronn, German Federal Republic; Hachioji, Japan; Penang, Malaysia; Aguadilla, Puerto Rico; South Queensferry, Scotland; and Singapore.
