

## **RPQ Section**

The following conventions are being followed on most of the feature card RPQ's attached to SERIES/1.

The most outstanding exception to this rule is the 4978 attachment which, because of it's impact on the DCP, is handled as a normal feature.

Familiarity with these conventions will help in the identification as well as support structures of RPQ features encountered.

- 1. RPQ documentation such as maps, listings, and ALD's are printed on green paper.
- 2. RPQ MAP Programs fall within the range of 8000 to 9FFF.
- 3. Configurator program will alert the CE to the presence of RPQ's which have a configuration record entry.
- RPQ Feature cards and cables may have green cloth identification tags affixed.
- 5. A brief description of the RPQ Feature as well as the configuration record information will be contained in the prologue of it's maps.
- 6. Custom feature manuals, maintenance information manuals when applicable, will be multi-hole punched for inclusion in the Maintenance Library and will be part of the ship group.
- 7. All unique map programs supporting RPQ's will be loaded from separate diskettes without using IPL.
