
READ THIS FIRST

This document provides the basic instructions for unpacking and organizing your Xerox Network Services 11.0 software and documentation for 8000 servers. Follow the instructions in the order they are presented.

Check to make sure you received all the items you ordered. If not, contact your Xerox Representative.

Unpack the box containing the Network Administration Library

This box contains the following:

- Roadmap to Network Services Documentation
- Multiple documentation packages with the following binders:
 - Guide to System Administration Activities
 - Activities Guide
 - Library Directory
 - Services Installation and Setup Guide
 - Services Maintenance Guide
 - Backup and Restore Guide
 - Interactive Terminal Service User Guide
 - Basic Network Troubleshooting: MP Codes and Messages
 - Basic Network Troubleshooting: Test and Diagnostic Tools
 - Basic Network Troubleshooting: Fault Isolation Process
- Three slipcasses to store the Network Administration Library

Assemble the documentation in the binders

Remove the contents from each slipcase. Remove the documentation package from each binder, unwrap it, and assemble the contents in the binder, inserting the tabs in the appropriate places. Return the assembled binders to the appropriate slipcase.

Note: The Activities Guide is an empty binder for storing service information.

Unpack the box "Standard Services System Software . . . Services 11.0"

With the initial purchase of the Xerox Network Services 11.0 software, you received the following:

- Services 11.0 Release Document

- Network Services 11.0 standard software diskettes in a diskette container
 - An empty diskette container for the optional Services 11.0 software

Store the 11.0 Release Document

Remove the wrapping from the *Services 11.0 Release Document* and place it in the front of the binder titled *Guide to System Administration Activities* in the Network Administration Library.

Unpack the diskette container

Remove the Network Services 11.0 software diskettes from the diskette container. Remove the wrappings and return the diskettes to the container.

Prerequisites for software installation

Before you begin to install software on your Xerox 8000 Network System servers, you must be familiar with the following:

- The contents of the *Guide to System Administration Activities* in the Network Administration Library. This book contains an overview of the Network System and describes the duties of the System Administrator. It provides information to help you install, setup, maintain, and troubleshoot the network server and services software.
- The contents of the *Services 11.0 Release Document*. This document provides a summary of new features and the current "Notes and cautions" for each application. It also provides complete procedures for upgrading your software from 10.0 or 10.3.

Note: Upgrade and installation of your software should be closely coordinated and planned with the Xerox Systems Analyst. Follow all recommendations made by the Systems Analyst.

Software upgrade/installation

When you are familiar with the prerequisites for software installation, you are ready to upgrade/install software on your Xerox 8000 Network System servers.

Upgrading software to 11.0

To upgrade your software to version 11.0, use the "Upgrade procedures" section of the *Services 11.0 Release Document*. This document provides the step-by-step procedures for upgrading a 10.0 or 10.3 based server to Services 11.0.

Note: You must read and understand the entire "Upgrade procedures" section prior to starting the upgrade. Be sure to follow these procedures exactly as they are written.

First time software installation

For first time installation of software, see the Server software installation chapter in the *Services Installation and Setup Guide*. This book provides step-by-step procedures to install your software properly. It is essential that you read and follow these steps exactly as they are written to avoid the consequences of incorrectly installed services.
