## Student Resource Kits Shift to New Host

From 1 February 1995, all student Network Resource Kits will shift from the current host *dingo*, to a new host called *student.uq.edu.au*.

Each student account on *dingo* will be created on *student.uq.edu.au* with the same username and password. Mail and files for each account will also be transferred. Staff (including visiting staff) and external accounts will be unaffected.

The new email address for student accounts is *username@student.uq.edu.au*.

Aliases will be maintained, and the current email address will still work for the remainder of 1995. From 1996, the old address will not work.

One consequence of the address change may be that it is no longer possible to automatically unsubscribe from listserv/majordomo mailing lists, subscribed to with your old address. We suggest you unsubscribe to all of your mailing lists on 31 January, and resubscribe on 1 February, otherwise you will have to write to the list administrator and request resubscription under your new address.

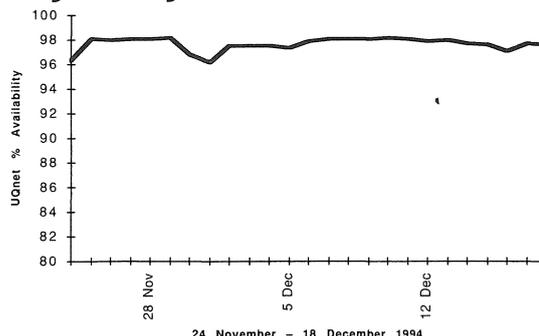
Students who use *dingo* as a pop server (eg, for Eudora email) will need to reconfigure their pop to use the new server and new email address.

## UQnet Availability fairly consistent

UQnet's Availability has been fairly consistent at around 98%, as illustrated in the graph.

The dip in availability early in December was due to the successful early morning cutover of new packet-routing equipment. QTAC was not available 3 – 4 December because of an airconditioning fault.



## Students must Revalidate Accounts

All student accounts (Dial-in Access and Resource Kits) must be revalidated at the beginning of this semester.

To revalidate your account, come to the Client Service counter at the Prentice Centre and present your 1995 UQ student card. You will be required to sign a new set of terms and conditions relating to the use of your account. It is no longer necessary to obtain authorisation from your Head of Department. Students will maintain their account throughout their student life at this University.

Your username will remain the same, unless you have a Dial-in Access username beginning with "s" which was obtained prior to October 1993. These students will be allocated a new username.

Accounts not revalidated by 10 March 1995 will be disabled. If they are still not revalidated by 7 April 1995, these accounts and their associated mail and files will be deleted.

## More Modems provide Easier Access

Dial-in Service clients will now find less congestion and easier access because Prentice has installed a new modem bank with 31 modems, taking the total to 74.

To connect to the new bank, clients must dial this number:

**870 3227**

The logon procedure for the new modem bank is the same as for the existing modem banks. (365 4900, 365 4916, 365 4055). Clients should still dial these numbers to access the other modem banks.

The new modem bank is based on General Datacomm modems, which handle speeds from 300 to 14400 bps.

## Modem Incompatibility

We have found that some clients' modems are not completely compatible with the UQ modem bank. These are:

- Netcomm E7 and E7F,
- Banksia 14-4k,
- Avtek CD960,
- Maestro 2400 & latest 14-4k executive,
- Dynalink 14-4k ,
- Spirit 14-4k.

To ensure a trouble free connection we suggest you do the following:

### Maestro 2400

In the case of the Maestro 2400, include B8 in your initialisation or dial string. For example: ATB8DT3654900

### Other Modems

For the rest of the modems mentioned, there is an incompatibility in regards to the implementation of V.42 and V.42bis error correction and compression. You need to force the modem to use MNP error correction and compression. The following should be included in your initialisation or dial string: X3N5%C1 Example dial string:

ATX3N5%C1DT3654055

If using an automatic dial script in your communications program, make sure that the “\” and “%” characters are not special characters within that program. An example of this is Peter Tattums Winsock. The “\” character is seen as a carriage return so you need to enclose it in quotes (“ ”).
