


Supply Chain Strategy Overview





Functionality Summary – Demand/Supply matching, inventory positioning, and PO management


Visibility Types:

Functionality Summary – Customer Order fulfillment and visibility in outsourced manufacturing environment




Visibility Types:

Visibility Solutions: PSG Supplier Collaboration



Functionality Summary – Demand/Supply and Inventory Visibility and Positioning across the entire supply chain.

Visibility Types:

1. Visibility to forecast & commits data
2. Visibility to shipments (inbound & outbound) & receipts data
3. Visibility to current & projected inventory levels at all locations
4. Visibility to aggregated order backlog – both released & unreleased sales orders

Usage: Monitors; 5 suppliers; expansion to begin in 2007

Geographies: NA in production, EMEA & AP scheduled 2H06
