About This Card

The instructions in this card describe how to install the Enterprise Virtual Array System Software.

Introduction

The *Compaq StorageWorks*™ Enterprise Virtual Array is initially configured with the Enterprise Virtual Array System Software preinstalled. This software kit contains Virtual Controller Software (VCS), Environmental Monitoring Unit (EMU) firmware, programmable component images, diagnostics, and message files.

A copy of the Enterprise Virtual Array System Software has been provided on CD-ROM. Because the software has already been preinstalled, this CD-ROM need only be used for recovery or on an as needed basis.

If you need to perform an install using this CD-ROM, Compaq recommends that you contact your service representative prior to beginning the installation process. Make sure you follow these guidelines when installing the System Software.

- Always install the software from the HSV Element Manager.
- The Enterprise Virtual Array System Software must be accessible on the client from which you are browsing.

NOTE: The scripting utility cannot be used to install this software.

Installation Instructions

To install the Enterprise Virtual Array System Software, complete the following steps:

1. Log in to the Compaq SANworks Management Appliance from your web browser.
2. Launch the HSV Element Manager by clicking the Resource Managers folder icon and then the Element Manager folder icon.
3. Click the HSV Element Manager icon and then the Launch icon in the Content pane.
4. Select the HSV system to be upgraded.
5. Select the Code Load option from the Initialized Storage System Properties pane.
6. Specify the filename and location of the Firmware file that you accessed from the installation CD-ROM.
7. After you enter the filename and location, click the Finish icon. Read and follow the displayed directions. The Code Load process will begin after you agree to proceed.
After the Code Load process is complete, a Completed pane will appear.
8. Read and follow the directions in the Completed pane, and click Finish.
