



# Removing Anonymous Access...

- ◆ Open *Internet Information Services*
- ◆ From the navigation tree, expand the Web Server and Default Web Site
- ◆ Right Click on '*RDA*', select *Properties*
- ◆ Click on *Directory Security*
- ◆ Click on *Edit* under *Anonymous access and authentication control*
- ◆ De-select *Anonymous access*

# IIS Security Exceptions...

- ◆ Certain files must remain accessible via Anonymous entry.
  - ◆ bsquareRM.mdb
  - ◆ hereiam.asp
  - ◆ “\Includes” Directory
- ◆ Re-enable Anonymous access on these exceptions.

# NTFS File-level Security

- ◆ Open Explorer
- ◆ Navigate to ...\\wwwroot
- ◆ Right-click on \\RDA, select Properties
- ◆ Goto Security
- ◆ Set desired Security using NTFS Security

# NTFS File-level Security

- ◆ Make sure that the following have Read&Execute permissions for "Everyone"
  - ◆ bsquareRM.mdb
  - ◆ hereiam.asp
  - ◆ "\Includes" Directory
