## **About the ThinkPad Multiple Battery Charger**

The IBM® ThinkPad® Multiple Battery Charger has two unique connectors. Each connector attaches to the battery firmly, regardless of the thickness of the battery. You can use the charger option for the battery and bay battery packs used in the following ThinkPads:

- · ThinkPad X-series computer
- ThinkPad T-series computer
- ThinkPad R-series computer (Li-Ion only)
- ThinkPad A-series computer
- ThinkPad TransNote<sup>™</sup> computer

**Note:** For other IBM ThinkPads, contact your IBM authorized dealer or IBM marketing representative to determine if the batteries for those models can be used with this charger option.


One battery pack charges at a time with the charger option. If you connect two battery packs to the charger, they are charged in the order in which they are connected. The charger has indicators that show the charging status. To use the charger option, you need a ThinkPad ac adapter.

#### Hardware Identification

The following illustration shows the charger hardware.




**1 5** These **connectors** are for connecting the battery pack to the charger option.

- **2 6** The **battery status indicators** show the charging status of the batteries that are connected to connectors **1 5** respectively.
- Blinking green When you connect the battery pack to the connector, this indicator blinks. If charging does not start, the indicator turns off.
- Green Shows that the charging has been completed.
- Orange Shows that the battery pack is charging.
- **Blinking Orange** Indicates the battery may not be connected properly. Reconnect the battery. If the indicator continues to blink orange, there is a problem with the battery. Refer to "Service and support" on page A-1.
- **3** The **power on indicator** turns green when you connect the ac adapter to the charger.
- 4 The **power jack** is where the ac adapter is connected.


## Using the charger option

To connect the charger option to the battery pack, do the following:


- Connect a ThinkPad computer ac adapter into the power jack in the charger option.
- 2. Place the connector holder of the charger option against the surface of the battery pack, as shown in this figure showing the side view.



3. Slide the connector straight into the battery pack.



**Attention:** When disconnecting the connector from the battery pack, pull the connector straight out. Do not bend or twist the connector.





## Informationen zum ThinkPad Multiple Battery Charger

Der IBM ThinkPad Multiple Battery Charger verfügt über zwei einzigartige Anschlüsse. Jeder Anschluss kann unabhängig von der Stärke des Akkus fest mit dem Akku verbunden werden. Sie können das Akkuladegerät für die Akkus der folgenden ThinkPad-Modelle verwenden:

- · ThinkPad der X-Serie
- ThinkPad der T-Serie
- ThinkPad der R-Serie (nur Li-Ion)
- · ThinkPad der A-Serie


Mit dem Akkuladegerät kann immer nur jeweils ein Akkusatz aufgeladen werden. Wenn Sie zwei Akkusätze an das Ladegerät anschließen, werden sie in der Reihenfolge aufgeladen, in der sie angeschlossen werden. Das Aufladegerät verfügt über Anzeigen, die den Aufladezustand anzeigen. Zur Verwendung des Akkuladegeräts benötigen Sie das Netzteil des ThinkPads.

## Beschreibung der Hardware




- 1 5 Über die Anschlüsse wird der Akkusatz an das Ladegerät angeschlossen.
- 2 6 Über die Statusanzeigen des Akkus wird der Ladezustand der Akkus angezeigt, die jeweils an die Anschlüsse 1 5 angeschlossen sind.
  - Grün blinkend Wird der Akku an den Anschluss angeschlossen, blinkt diese Anzeige. Wenn der Aufladevorgang nicht beginnt, erlischt die Anzeige.
  - Grün Zeigt an, dass der Akku vollständig aufgeladen ist.
  - Orange Zeigt an, dass der Akku gerade aufgeladen wird.
  - Orange blinkend Zeigt an, dass der Akku möglicherweise nicht ordnungsgemäß angeschlossen ist. Schließen Sie den Akku erneut an. Wenn die Anzeige weiterhin orange blinkt, liegt ein Fehler am Akku vor. Weitere Informationen finden Sie unter "Service and support" auf Seite A-1.
- Die **Betriebsanzeige** leuchtet grün auf, wenn Sie das Netzteil an das Akkuladegerät anschließen.
- Das Netzteil wird an den Netzteilanschluss angeschlossen.


## Akkuladegerät verwenden

Gehen Sie wie folgt vor, um das Akkuladegerät an den Akkusatz anzuschließen:


- Schließen Sie das Netzteil des ThinkPads an den Netzteilanschluss am Akkuladegerät an.
- 2. Positionieren Sie die Anschlusshalterung des Akkuladegeräts an der Oberfläche des Akkusatzes wie in der folgenden Abbildung, in der die Seitenansicht dargestellt ist.




3. Schieben Sie den Anschluss gerade in das Akku.

## A propos du chargeur de batteries ThinkPad

Le chargeur de batteries multiples <sup>®</sup> ThinkPad <sup>®</sup> d'IBM est équipé de deux connecteurs simples. Chaque connecteur est fixé solidement à la batterie, quelle que soit l'épaisseur de celle-ci. Vous pouvez utiliser l'option chargeur avec les batteries et baies avec les ThinkPad suivants :

- · ordinateur ThinkPad X-series
- · ordinateur ThinkPad T-series
- ordinateur ThinkPad R-series (Li-Ion uniquement)
- ordinateur ThinkPad A-series
- · ordinateur ThinkPad TransNote

Remarque: Pour les autres Thinkpad IBM, prenez contact avec votre revendeur agréé IBM ou avec votre partenaire commercial IBM pour déterminer si vous pouvez utiliser l'option chargeur avec les batteries de ces modèles d'ordinateur.


L'option chargeur ne charge qu'une seule batterie à la fois. Si vous connectez deux batteries au chargeur, elles sont chargées dans l'ordre dans lequel vous les avez connectées. Des indicateurs placés sur le chargeur permettent de suivre l'état du chargement. Pour pouvoir utiliser l'option chargeur, vous devez disposer d'un boîtier d'alimentation ThinkPad.

#### Identification du matériel

L'illustration ci-après présente le matériel du chargeur.




- 1 5 Ces connecteurs servent à connecter les batteries à l'option chargeur.
- 2 6 Les indicateurs de charge donnent respectivement le statut de chaque batterie en charge liée à un connecteur donné 1 5.
- Signal vert clignotant Lorsque vous connectez un bloc de batteries au connecteur, l'indicateur clignote. Si le chargement ne commence pas, l'indicateur s'éteint.
- Signal vert Indique que le chargement est terminé.
- Signal orange Indique que le bloc de batteries est en cours de chargement.
- Signal orange clignotant Indique que la batterie est probablement mal connectée. Reconnectez la batterie. Si l'indicateur orange continue de clignoter, cela signifie qu'il s'agit d'un problème relatif à la batterie. Reportez-vous à «Service and support» à la page A-1.
- 3 L'indicateur de mise sous tension prend la couleur verte lorsque vous connectez le boîtier d'alimentation au chargeur.
- 4 La **prise d'alimentation** permet de raccorder le boîtier d'alimentation.


## Utilisation de l'option chargeur

Pour connecter l'option chargeur au bloc de batterie, procédez comme suit :


- 1. Connectez un adaptateur en courant alternatif ThinkPad computer à la prise d'alimentation de l'option de chargeur.
- 2. Placez le support de connecteur de l'option chargeur contre la surface du bloc de batterie, comme l'indique la figure présentant la vue de profil du dispositif.



3. Faites glisser le connecteur directement dans la batterie.

## Acerca del Cargador de baterías múltiple de ThinkPad

El Cargador de baterías múltiple de ThinkPad<sup>®</sup> de IBM<sup>®</sup> tiene dos conectores exclusivos. Cada conector se conecta a la batería fuertemente, sin tener en cuenta el ancho de la batería. Puede utilizar la opción de cargador con la batería y paquetes de baterías y bahías utilizadas en los siguientes sistemas ThinkPad:

- Sistema ThinkPad X-series
- · Sistema ThinkPad T-series
- Sistema ThinkPad R-series (solamente con baterías de iones de litio)
- · Sistema ThinkPad A-series
- · Sistema ThinkPad TransNote

**Nota:** Para otros sistemas ThinkPad de IBM, póngase en contacto con un distribuidor autorizado de IBM o con un representante de ventas de IBM para determinar si las baterías de dichos modelos se pueden utilizar con esta opción de cargador.


Un paquete de baterías se carga de una sola vez con la opción de cargador. Si conecta dos paquetes de baterías al cargador, se cargan en el mismo orden en el que se hayan conectado. El cargador dispone de indicadores que muestran el estado del proceso de carga. Para utilizar la opción de cargador, precisará el adaptador de CA de ThinkPad.

#### Identificación del hardware




- **1 5** Estos **conectores** se utilizan para conectar el paquete de baterías a la opción de cargador.
- **2 6** Los **indicadores de estado de la batería** muestran el estado de la carga de las baterías que están conectadas a los conectores **1 5** respectivamente.
- Verde parpadeante Este indicador parpadea cuando se conecta el paquete de baterías al conector. Si no se inicia la carga, el indicador se apaga.
- Verde Muestra que se ha completado la carga.
- Naranja Muestra que se está cargando el paquete de baterías.
- Naranja parpadeante Indica que es posible que la batería no esté conectada correctamente. Vuelva a conectar la batería. Si el indicador continúa parpadeando en naranja, existe un problema con la batería. Consulte el apartado "Service and support" en la página A-1.
- **3** El **indicador de encendido** se pone en verde cuando conecta el adaptador de CA al cargador.
- 4 El **conector de alimentación** es el lugar en el que se conecta el adaptador de CA.


## Utilización de la opción de cargador

Para conectar la opción de cargador al paquete de baterías, haga lo siguiente:


- 1. Conecte un adaptador de CA del sistema ThinkPad a la toma de alimentación que se encuentra en la opción de cargador.
- 2. Sitúe el soporte de conector de la opción de cargador contra la superficie del paquete de baterías, tal y como se muestra en la siguiente figura en la que aparece una vista lateral.



3. Deslice el conector directamente en el paquete de baterías.



**Atención:** Cuando desconecte el conector del paquete de baterías, tire del conector directamente hacia afuera. No doble o retuerza el conector.

Il caricatore della batteria multipla<sup>®</sup> ThinkPad<sup>®</sup> IBM ha due connettori. Ciascun connettore si collega alla batteria, indipendentemente dallo spessore. E' possibile utilizzare il caricatore della batteria ThinkPad e delle batteria del vano riportate di seguito:

- Elaboratore ThinkPad X-series
- Elaboratore ThinkPad T-series


Viene caricata una batteria alla volta utilizzando il caricatore. Se vengono collegate due batterie al caricatore, esse vengono caricate nell'ordine in cui vengono collegate. 

- Verde lampeggiante Quando si collega la batteria al connettore, questo indicatore lampeggia. Se non viene avviato il caricamento, l'indicatore si spegne.
- Verde Indica che la batteria è carica.

- 3 L'indicatore di accensione è verde quando viene collegato l'adattatore CA al caricatore.





O Carregador de Bateria Múltiplo IBM<sup>®</sup> ThinkPad<sup>®</sup> possui dois conectores exclusivos. Cada conector é conectado à bateria firmemente, independente da espessura da bateria. Você pode utilizar o carregador para a bateria e para as baterias de compartimento, utilizadas nos seguintes ThinkPads:





- Verde intermitente Quando você conecta a bateria ao conector, esse indicador pisca. Se o carregamento não for iniciado, o indicador se apagará.
- Verde Mostra que o carregamento foi concluído.
- Laranja Mostra que a bateria está carregando.
- Laranja intermitente Indica que a bateria pode não estar conectada adequadamente. Conecte-a novamente. Se o indicador continuar piscando laranja, há um problema com a bateria. Consulte "Service and support" na página A-1.
- **3** O **indicador de inicialização** fica verde quando você conecta o adaptador CA ao carregador.





















This warranty statement consists of two parts: Part 1 and Part 2. Be sure to read Part 1 and the country-unique terms in Part 2 that apply to your country or region.

#### Part 1 - General Terms

This Statement of Limited Warranty includes Part 1 - General Terms and Part 2 - Country-unique Terms. The terms of Part 2 replace or modify those of Part 1. The warranties provided by IBM in this Statement of Limited Warranty apply only to Machines you purchase for your use, and not for resale, from IBM or your reseller. The term "Machine" means an IBM machine, its features, conversions, upgrades, elements, or accessories, or any combination of them. The term "Machine" does not include any software programs, whether pre-loaded with the Machine, installed subsequently or otherwise. Unless IBM specifies otherwise, the following warranties apply only in the country where you acquire the Machine. Nothing in this Statement of Limited Warranty affects any statutory rights of consumers that cannot be waived or limited by contract. If you have any questions, contact IBM or your reseller.

#### The IBM Warranty for Machines

IBM warrants that each Machine 1) is free from defects in materials and workmanship and 2) conforms to IBM's Official Published Specifications ("Specifications"). The warranty period for a Machine is a specified, fixed period commencing on its Date of Installation. The date on your sales receipt is the Date of Installation unless IBM or your reseller informs you otherwise.

If a Machine does not function as warranted during the warranty period, and IBM or your reseller are unable to either 1) make it do so or 2) replace it with one that is at least functionally equivalent, you may return it to your place of purchase and your money will be refunded.

#### **Extent of Warranty**

The warranty does not cover the repair or exchange of a Machine resulting from misuse, accident, modification, unsuitable physical or operating environment, improper maintenance by you, or failure caused by a product for which IBM is not responsible. The warranty is voided by removal or alteration of Machine or parts identification labels.

THESE WARRANTIES ARE YOUR EXCLUSIVE WARRANTIES AND REPLACE ALL OTHER WARRANTIES OR CONDITIONS, EXPRESS OR IMPLIED, INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, THE IMPLIED WARRANTIES OR CONDITIONS OF MERCHANTABILITY AND FITNESS FOR A PARTICULAR PURPOSE. THESE WARRANTIES GIVE YOU SPECIFIC LEGAL RIGHTS AND YOU MAY ALSO HAVE OTHER RIGHTS WHICH VARY FROM JURISDICTION TO JURISDICTION. SOME JURISDICTIONS DO NOT ALLOW THE EXCLUSION OR LIMITATION OF EXPRESS OR IMPLIED WARRANTIES, SO THE ABOVE EXCLUSION OR LIMITATION MAY NOT APPLY TO YOU. IN THAT EVENT, SUCH

## WARRANTIES ARE LIMITED IN DURATION TO THE WARRANTY PERIOD. NO WARRANTIES APPLY AFTER THAT PERIOD.

#### Items Not Covered by Warranty

IBM does not warrant uninterrupted or error-free operation of a Machine.

Any technical or other support provided for a Machine under warranty, such as assistance via telephone with "how-to" questions and those regarding Machine set-up and installation, will be provided WITHOUT WARRANTIES OF ANY KIND.

#### Warranty Service

To obtain warranty service for a Machine, contact IBM or your reseller. If you do not register your Machine with IBM, you may be required to present proof of purchase.

During the warranty period, IBM or your reseller, if approved by IBM to provide warranty service, provides without charge certain types of repair and exchange service to keep Machines in, or restore them to, conformance with their Specifications. IBM or your reseller will inform you of the available types of service for a Machine based on its country of installation. The replacement assumes the warranty service status of the replaced item. Many features, conversions, or upgrades involve the removal of parts and their return to IBM. A part that replaces a removed part will assume the warranty service status of the removed part.

Before IBM or your reseller exchanges a Machine or part, you agree to remove all features, parts, options, alterations, and attachments not under warranty service.

You also agree to

- 2. obtain authorization from the owner to have IBM or your reseller service a Machine that you do not own; and

  - d. inform IBM or your reseller of changes in a Machine's location.

IBM is responsible for loss of, or damage to, your Machine while it is 1) in IBM's possession or 2) in transit in those cases where IBM is responsible for the transportation charges.

Neither IBM nor your reseller is responsible for any of your confidential, proprietary or personal information contained in a Machine which you return to IBM or your reseller for any reason. You should remove all such information from the Machine prior to its return.

#### Limitation of Liability

Circumstances may arise where, because of a default on IBM's part or other liability, you are entitled to recover damages from IBM. In each such instance, regardless of the basis on which you are entitled to claim damages from IBM (including fundamental breach, negligence, misrepresentation, or other contract or tort claim), except for any liability that cannot be waived or limited by applicable laws, IBM is liable for no more than

- 1. damages for bodily injury (including death) and damage to real property and tangible personal property; and
- the amount of any other actual direct damages, up to the charges (if recurring, 12 months' charges apply) for the Machine that is subject of the claim. For purposes of this item, the term "Machine" includes Machine Code and Licensed Internal Code.

This limit also applies to IBM's suppliers and your reseller. It is the maximum for which IBM, its suppliers, and your reseller are collectively responsible.

UNDER NO CIRCUMSTANCES IS IBM LIABLE FOR ANY OF THE FOLLOWING: 1) THIRD-PARTY CLAIMS AGAINST YOU FOR DAMAGES

(OTHER THAN THOSE UNDER THE FIRST ITEM LISTED ABOVE); 2) LOSS OF, OR DAMAGE TO, YOUR RECORDS OR DATA; OR 3) SPECIAL, INCIDENTAL, OR INDIRECT DAMAGES OR FOR ANY ECONOMIC CONSEQUENTIAL DAMAGES, LOST PROFITS OR LOST SAVINGS, EVEN IF IBM, ITS SUPPLIERS OR YOUR RESELLER IS INFORMED OF THEIR POSSIBILITY. SOME JURISDICTIONS DO NOT ALLOW THE EXCLUSION OR LIMITATION OF INCIDENTAL OR CONSEQUENTIAL DAMAGES, SO THE ABOVE LIMITATION OR EXCLUSION MAY NOT APPLY TO YOU.

#### Governing Law

Both you and IBM consent to the application of the laws of the country in which you acquired the Machine to govern, interpret, and enforce all of your and IBM's rights, duties, and obligations arising from, or relating in any manner to, the subject matter of this Agreement, without regard to conflict of law principles.

The English language version of this Agreement prevails over any other language version.

Both you and IBM consent to the application of the laws of the State of New York (except when local law requires otherwise) to govern, interpret, and enforce all your and IBM's rights, duties, and obligations arising from, or relating in any manner to, the subject matter of this Agreement, without regard to conflict of law principles.

Any disputes arising from or in connection with this Agreement will first be resolved by friendly negotiations, failing which either of us has the right to submit the dispute to the China International Economic and Trade Arbitration Commission in Beijing, the PRC, for arbitration in accordance with its arbitration rules in force at the time. The arbitration tribunal will consist of three arbitrators. The language to be used therein will be English and Chinese. An arbitral award will be final and binding on all the parties, and will be enforceable under the Convention on the Recognition and Enforcement of Foreign Arbitral Awards (1958).

The arbitration fee will be borne by the losing party unless otherwise determined by the arbitral award.

During the course of arbitration, this Agreement will continue to be performed except for the part which the parties are disputing and which is undergoing arbitration.
