About the ThinkPad Enhanced Drive Adapter for Ultrabay 2000


This user's guide provides information on registering, installing, and uninstalling the ThinkPad® Enhanced Drive Adapter for Ultrabay™ 2000.

Product description

The ThinkPad Enhanced Drive Adapter for Ultrabay 2000 (hereafter called the *enhanced drive adapter*) enables you to use an Ultrabay Enhanced drive with a computer that has an Ultrabay 2000 bay.

Installing the enhanced drive adapter

To install the enhanced drive adapter in the Ultrabay 2000 bay of your computer, complete the following procedure:

1. Lay the drive upside down on a flat surface.




Figure 1-1. Aligning the connectors

2. Hold the adapter upside down and line it up with the drive so that the mini connectors on the drive and adapter align, as shown in Figure 1-1.




Figure 1-2. Sliding connector into drive

3. Carefully slide the adaptor connector into the drive, while ensuring that the short leg of the adapter interlocks with the side of the drive, as shown in Figure 1-2.




Figure 1-3. Adapter screws

4. Tighten the side screw **A** clockwise until the long adapter leg is snug against the drive. See Figure 1-3.

Note: The adapter screws are knurled to assist with installing the adapter by hand. A small screwdriver may be required to fully seat the screws for installation.

Note: It is important to fully seat the side screw to prevent the drive from becoming wedged in the bay.

5. Tighten the back screw **B** clockwise until the adapter is snug against the drive. See Figure 1-3.

Notes:

1. To install an Ultrabay enhanced slim drive in an Ultrabay 2000 bay, insert it into the enhanced drive adapter first. Then you can install the enhanced drive adapter in either of the following places:
 - In the Ultrabay 2000 of a qualified ThinkPad computer, except a ThinkPad T40 or T50 Series computer. To obtain a list of qualified computers, visit the Web site at <http://www.ibm.com/support>, and search under "Enhanced Drive Adapter."
 - In the Ultrabay 2000 of a ThinkPad Dock II.
2. To install a device into the Ultrabay 2000 bay of your ThinkPad computer, or to remove it, refer to Access IBM, the on-board help system for the computer.

Uninstalling the enhanced drive adapter

To uninstall the enhanced drive adapter, complete the following procedure:

1. Loosen the screws, shown in Figure 1-3, by turning them counterclockwise.

Note: The adapter screws are knurled to assist with uninstalling the adapter by hand. A small screwdriver may be required to loosen the screws.




Figure 1-4. Removing the adapter from the drive

2. Gently pull the adapter and drive apart, as shown in Figure 1-4.



Installation de l'adaptateur évolué d'unité

Pour installer l'adaptateur évolué d'unité dans la baie Ultrabay 2000 de votre ordinateur, procédez comme suit :

1. Posez l'unité à l'envers sur une surface plate.




Figure 1-1. Alignement des connecteurs

2. Maintenez l'adaptateur à l'envers et alignez-le avec l'unité afin que les connecteurs de l'unité et de l'adaptateur se rencontrent, comme illustré à la figure figure 1-1.




Figure 1-2. Glissement du connecteur dans l'unité

3. Faites glisser délicatement le connecteur de l'adaptateur dans l'unité tout en vous assurant que le petit loquet de l'adaptateur s'enclenche sur le côté de l'unité, comme illustré à la figure figure 1-2 à la page 1-7.




Figure 1-3. Vis de l'adaptateur

4. Serrez la vis latérale **A** en tournant dans le sens des aiguilles d'une montre jusqu'à ce que le long loquet soit ajusté contre l'unité. Voir figure 1-3.

Remarque : Les vis de l'adaptateur sont moletées pour permettre l'installation manuelle de l'adaptateur. Un petit tournevis peut être nécessaire pour terminer l'installation.

Remarque : Il est important de bien mettre en place la vis latérale afin d'empêcher l'unité d'être coincée dans la baie.

5. Serrez la vis arrière **B** en tournant dans le sens des aiguilles d'une montre jusqu'à ce que l'adaptateur soit ajusté contre l'unité. Voir figure 1-3.

Remarques :

1. Pour installer une unité Ultrabay Enhanced Slim dans une baie Ultrabay 2000, vous devez d'abord l'insérer dans l'adaptateur évolué d'unité. Vous pouvez ensuite installer ce dernier dans l'un des emplacements suivants :
 - Dans l'unité Ultrabay 2000 d'un ordinateur ThinkPad, à l'exception des modèles T40 et T50 Series. Pour obtenir la liste des ordinateurs adaptés, visitez le site Web à l'adresse suivante :

 - Dans l'unité Ultrabay 2000 d'une station d'accueil ThinkPad Dock II.

Désinstallation de l'adaptateur évolué d'unité

Pour désinstaller l'adaptateur évolué d'unité, procédez comme suit :

1. Desserrez les vis, comme indiqué à la figure figure 1-3, en tournant dans le sens inverse des aiguilles d'une montre.




Figure 1-4. Retrait de l'adaptateur de l'unité

2. Séparez doucement l'adaptateur de l'unité, comme indiqué à la figure figure 1-4.



Installazione dell'adattatore unità potenziata

Per installare l'adattatore unità potenziata nel vano Ultrabay 2000 dell'elaboratore, completare la seguente procedura:

1. Capovolgere l'unità e posizionarla su una superficie piatta.
2. Tenere l'adattatore capovolto ed allinearlo all'unità in modo che i mini connettori sull'unità e sull'adattatore siano allineati, come mostrato in Figura 1-1.




Figura 1-1. Allineamento dei connettori

3. Introdurre delicatamente il connettore dell'adattatore nell'unità, assicurandosi che la linguetta dell'adattatore si incastri con il lato dell'unità, come mostrato in Figura 1-2.




Figura 1-2. Inserimento del connettore nell'unità

4. Avvitare la vite laterale **A** in senso orario in modo che la linguetta lunga sia installata nell'unità. Consultare la sezione Figura 1-3.




Figura 1-3. Viti dell'adattatore

Nota: Le viti dell'adattatore sono zigrinate per facilitare l'installazione manuale dell'adattore. E' necessario un piccolo cacciavite per le viti durante l'installazione.

Nota: E' importante installare bene la vite laterale per impedire che l'unità non sia ben fissata nel vano.

5. Avvitare la vite posteriore **B** in senso orario in modo che l'adattatore sia inserito nell'unità. Consultare la sezione Figura 1-3.

Note:

1. Per installare un'unità piatta potenziata Ultrabay in un vano Ultrabay 2000, inserirla prima nell'adattatore unità potenziata. Successivamente è possibile installare l'adattatore unità potenziata in una delle seguenti ubicazioni:

- Nota:** Le viti dell'adattatore sono zigrinate per facilitare la disinstallazione manuale dell'adattore. E' necessario un piccolo cacciavite per allentare le viti.
2. Rimuovere delicatamente l'adattatore dall'unità, come mostrato in Figura 1-4.




Figura 1-4. Rimozione dell'adattatore dall'unità



Erweiterten Laufwerkadapter installieren

Gehen Sie wie folgt vor, um den erweiterten Laufwerkadapter in der Ultrabay 2000-Position Ihres Computers zu installieren:

1. Legen Sie das Laufwerk mit der Oberseite nach unten auf eine ebene Fläche.
2. Drehen Sie den Adapter ebenfalls um, und richten Sie ihn so am Laufwerk aus, dass die Mini-Anschlüsse am Laufwerk mit denen am Adapter übereinstimmen (siehe hierzu Abb. 1-1).




Abbildung 1-1. Anschlüsse aneinander ausrichten

3. Schieben Sie den Adapteranschluss vorsichtig auf das Laufwerk. Stellen Sie dabei sicher, dass die kurze Seite des Adapters an der Seite des Laufwerks einrastet (siehe hierzu Abb. 1-2).




Abbildung 1-2. Adapteranschluss auf das Laufwerk schieben

- Ziehen Sie die seitliche Schraube **A** im Uhrzeigersinn fest, bis die lange (d. h. die andere) Seite des Adapters eng am Laufwerk anliegt. Siehe hierzu Abb. 1-3.




Abbildung 1-3. Schrauben am Adapter

Anmerkung: Die Schrauben am Adapter können mit den Fingern eingesetzt und festgezogen werden. Sie benötigen jedoch möglicherweise einen kleinen Schraubendreher, um die Schrauben richtig einzusetzen und festzuziehen.

Anmerkung: Beachten Sie, dass die seitliche Schraube richtig eingesetzt und festgezogen werden muss, damit sich das Laufwerk beim Einführen in die Position nicht verkantet.

- Ziehen Sie die hintere Schraube **B** im Uhrzeigersinn fest, bis der Adapter eng am Laufwerk anliegt. Siehe hierzu Abb. 1-3.

Anmerkungen:

- Um ein erweitertes flaches Ultrabay-Laufwerk in einer Ultrabay 2000-Position zu installieren, müssen Sie es zuerst in den erweiterten Laufwerkadapter einsetzen. Anschließend können Sie den erweiterten Laufwerkadapter in einer der folgenden Positionen installieren:

Erweiterten Laufwerkadapter deinstallieren

Gehen Sie wie folgt vor, um den erweiterten Laufwerkadapter zu deinstallieren:

1. Lösen Sie die Schrauben, wie in Abb. 1-3 dargestellt, indem Sie sie gegen den Uhrzeigersinn drehen.
- Anmerkung:** Die Schrauben am Adapter können mit den Fingern gelöst und entfernt werden. Möglicherweise benötigen Sie jedoch einen kleinen Schraubendreher, um die Schrauben zu lösen.
2. Ziehen Sie den Adapter vorsichtig vom Laufwerk ab (siehe hierzu Abb. 1-4).




Abbildung 1-4. Adapter vom Laufwerk abziehen



Instalación del adaptador de unidades mejoradas

Para instalar el adaptador de unidades mejoradas en la bahía Ultrabay 2000 de su sistema, realice el procedimiento siguiente:

1. Coloque la unidad al revés en una superficie plana.
2. Sujete el adaptador al revés y alinéelo con la unidad de forma que los miniconectores de la unidad estén alineados con los del adaptador, tal como se muestra en la Figura 1-1.




Figura 1-1. Cómo alinear los conectores

3. Deslice con precaución el conector del adaptador hacia la unidad, asegurándose de que la pata más corta del adaptador quede fija en la parte lateral de la unidad, tal como se muestra en la Figura 1-2 en la página 1-19.




Figura 1-2. Cómo deslizar el conector hacia la unidad

4. Atornille el tornillo lateral **A** en el sentido de las agujas del reloj hasta que la pata larga del adaptador quede ceñida a la unidad. Consulte la Figura 1-3.




Figura 1-3. Tornillos del adaptador

Nota: Los tornillos del adaptador disponen de una protuberancia para facilitar la instalación a mano del adaptador. Es posible que necesite un destornillador para ajustar totalmente los tornillos para la instalación.

Nota: Es importante ajustar totalmente el tornillo lateral para evitar que la unidad quede bloqueada en la bahía.

5. Atornille el tornillo posterior **B** en el sentido de las agujas del reloj hasta que el adaptador quede ceñido a la unidad. Consulte la Figura 1-3.

Notas:

1. Para instalar una unidad delgada mejorada Ultrabay en una bahía Ultrabay 2000, insértela primero en el adaptador de unidades mejoradas. A continuación podrá instalar el adaptador de unidades mejoradas en cualquiera de estos lugares:
 - En la bahía Ultrabay 2000 de un sistema ThinkPad cualificado, salvo en el sistema ThinkPad Serie T40 o T50. Para obtener una lista de los sistemas cualificados, visite el sitio web siguiente:

Desinstalación del adaptador de unidades mejoradas

Para desinstalar el adaptador de unidades mejoradas, realice el procedimiento siguiente:

1. Afloje los tornillos, mostrados en la Figura 1-3, girándolos en el sentido contrario al de las agujas del reloj.
- Nota:** Los tornillos del adaptador disponen de una protuberancia para facilitar la desinstalación a mano del adaptador. Es posible que necesite un destornillador para aflojar los tornillos.
2. Separe con precaución el adaptador de la unidad, tal como se muestra en la Figura 1-4.




Figura 1-4. Cómo extraer el adaptador de la unidad



Instalando o Adaptador de Unidade Melhorada

Para instalar o adaptador de unidade melhorada no compartimento Ultrabay 2000 do seu computador, conclua o procedimento a seguir:

1. Coloque a unidade de cabeça para baixo em uma superfície plana.
2. Segure o adaptador de cabeça para baixo e alinhe com a unidade para que os mini conectores se alinhem a unidade e ao adaptador, como mostrado na Figura 1-1.




Figura 1-1. Alinhando os Conectores

3. Deslize cuidadosamente o conector do adaptador na unidade, enquanto assegura-se de que o encaixe pequeno do adaptador se prenda à lateral da unidade, como mostrado na Figura 1-2.




Figura 1-2. Deslizando o Conector na Unidade

- Aperte o parafuso lateral **A** no sentido horário até que o encaixe longo do adaptador esteja preso à unidade. Consulte o Figura 1-3.




Figura 1-3. Parafusos do Adaptador

Nota: Os parafusos do adaptador estão recartilhados para ajudar a instalar o adaptador com as mãos. Uma pequena chave de fenda pode ser necessária, na instalação, para ajustar os parafusos totalmente.

Nota: É importante ajustar totalmente o parafuso lateral para evitar que a unidade fique calçada no compartimento.

- Aperte o parafuso posterior **B** no sentido horário até que o adaptador esteja preso à unidade. Consulte Figura 1-3.

Notas:

- Para instalar uma unidade de slim melhorada Ultrabay no compartimento Ultrabay 2000, insira-a no adaptador de unidade melhorada primeiramente. Assim, você pode instalar o adaptador de unidade melhorada nos locais a seguir:
 - No Ultrabay 2000 de um computador ThinkPad qualificado, exceto os computadores ThinkPad T40 ou T50 Series. Para obter uma lista de computadores qualificados, visite o Web site em <http://www.ibm.com/support>, e pesquise em "Enhanced Drive Adapter."




Figura 1-4. Removendo o Adaptador da Unidade




Obrázek 1-1. Srovnání konektorů








图 1-1. 对齐接口




图 1-2. 将接口滑入驱动器中




图 1-3. 适配器螺钉




图 1-4. 从驱动器卸下适配器






圖 1-1. 對齊接頭




圖 1-2. 將接頭滑入磁碟機內




圖 1-3. 轉接盒螺絲




圖 1-4. 從磁碟機移除轉接盒






図 1-1. コネクターの位置合わせ




図 1-2. ドライブへのコネクターの挿入




図 1-3. アダプターのねじ




図 1-4. ドライブからのアダプターの取り外し

What this Warranty Does not Cover

This warranty does not cover the following:

- failure resulting from misuse (including but not limited to use of any Machine capacity or capability, other than that authorized by IBM in writing), accident, modification, unsuitable physical or operating environment, or improper maintenance by you;
- failure caused by a product for which IBM is not responsible; and
- any non-IBM products, including those that IBM may procure and provide with or integrate into an IBM Machine at your request.

The warranty is voided by removal or alteration of identification labels on the Machine or its parts.

IBM does not warrant uninterrupted or error-free operation of a Machine.

Any technical or other support provided for a Machine under warranty, such as assistance via telephone with "how-to" questions and those regarding Machine set-up and installation, is provided **WITHOUT WARRANTIES OF ANY KIND.**

How to Obtain Warranty Service

If the Machine does not function as warranted during the warranty period, contact IBM or your reseller to obtain warranty service. If you do not register the Machine with IBM, you may be required to present proof of purchase as evidence of your entitlement to warranty service.

What IBM Will Do to Correct Problems

When you call for service, you must follow the problem determination and resolution procedures that IBM specifies. A technician will attempt to make an initial diagnosis of your problem and help you resolve it over the telephone.

The type of warranty service applicable to your Machine is specified in Part 3 - Warranty Information.

EXCLUSION MAY NOT APPLY TO YOU. SOME STATES OR JURISDICTIONS DO NOT ALLOW LIMITATIONS ON HOW LONG AN IMPLIED WARRANTY LASTS, SO THE ABOVE LIMITATION MAY NOT APPLY TO YOU.

Governing Law

Both you and IBM consent to the application of the laws of the country in which you acquired the Machine to govern, interpret, and enforce all of your and IBM's rights, duties, and obligations arising from, or relating in any manner to, the subject matter of this Statement of Limited Warranty, without regard to conflict of law principles.


