

IBM Datacenter Scalable solution help information

A complete IBM[®] Datacenter solution for your IBM server consists of supported software and hardware components that are interconnected and designed to provide scalability, reliability, and availability for applications and data access. The following items come with this software package:

- Microsoft[®] publications package for the operating system (Microsoft Windows[®] Server 2003 R2 32-bit Datacenter Edition or Microsoft Windows Server 2003 R2 x64 Datacenter Edition).
- IBM Product CD (for installing the operating system).
- This documentation.

For instructions for installing the operating system:

- 1. Go to http://www.ibm.com/servers/eserver/support/xseries/.
- 2. In the **Select Your Product** section, select your server type under **Hardware**, and Windows environment under **Software**.
- 3. Click Go. The support page for your server type displays.
- 4. Click on the Install and use tab, then select Product Documentation.
- 5. In the list of available documents, find and download the Installation Guide for your server type. Keep this document with your server and operating system documentation.
- **Note:** If you download and install updates from the Microsoft Support web site, you may need a Registry Key from IBM. If a Registry Key is required to complete installation, use the procedure below to set your Registry Key.

Setting the Registry Key

Notes:

- 1. Only use this procedure if you have downloaded and tried to install an operating system update directly from the Microsoft Support web site, and could not complete installation without a Registry Key.
- 2. For all named items in quotation marks below, the marks should not be included when you enter the name as directed.

To set this special registry key, do the following:

- 1. From the Start Menu, select Run.
- 2. At the Windows command prompt, enter the following command: regedit. The Registry Editor displays. .
- 3. Right-click on HKEY_LOCAL_MACHINE\SOFTWARE\Microsoft\Updates\Windows Server 2003, then select New->DWORD Value. Name the new registry key "DTCUpdate".
- 4. Double click on DTCUpdate. The Edit DWORD Value window displays. In the **Value data** field, type 1. Click **OK**.
- 5. Close the Registry Editor to exit. You do not need to restart after setting this key, as the new value has no effect on the system. You can add this new key immediately before you install the update (run update.exe).
 - **Note:** If HKEY_LOCAL_MACHINE\SOFTWARE\Microsoft\Updates\Windows Server 2003 is not present, you must create these keys manually:
 - a. Right-click on HKEY_LOCAL_MACHINE\SOFTWARE\Microsoft and select New->Key. Name the new registry key "Updates".

- b. Right-click on HKEY_LOCAL_MACHINE\SOFTWARE\Microsoft\Updates and select New->Key. Name the new registry key "Windows Server 2003". The entire key should now read:HKEY_LOCAL_MACHINE\SOFTWARE\Microsoft\Updates\Windows Server 2003.
- c. Refer to Steps 3-5 above to complete the registry edit.
